









According to the 2011-2015 population estimates, the city of Buckner had 3,077 residents. Of these, **5170** were female and **4970** were male. **9570** identified as White and **470** identified as Hispanic. In addition, **4070** attended college and **2370** had an income that was below the poverty level.
