

CAN MY CHILD GO TO SCHOOL TODAY?



Is your child feeling unwell?

NO

Has your child been in close contact with a person that tested positive for COVID-19?

NO

GO TO SCHOOL!

If your child has no known exposure and is symptom free, they may go to school.

YES

STAY HOME

Your child may not return to school and should not attend extracurricular activities until the following conditions are met:

- Your child must quarantine for 14 days based on the last day of exposure to the positive COVID-19 case.
- Monitor your child for symptom onset, and call your provider if symptoms develop. If symptoms develop within 48 hours of last day of school attendance, notify school.

Call school to notify of child's absence, and provide information on their exposure date and expected return to school.

Do they have **one (1)** of any of the following moderate-risk symptoms?

Fever of $\geq 100.4^\circ$ or chills, congestion/runny nose, nausea/vomiting/diarrhea, sore throat, headache, or muscle or body aches?

Do they have **two (2)** or more of any of the following moderate-risk symptoms?

Fever of $\geq 100.4^\circ$ or chills, congestion/runny nose, nausea/vomiting/diarrhea, sore throat, headache, or muscle or body aches?

Do they have **one (1)** or more of any of the following high-risk symptoms?

New cough, difficulty breathing, loss of taste or smell?

STAY HOME

Your child may not return to school and should not attend extracurricular activities until the following conditions are met:

- Fever-free for 24 hours* or symptom improvement.
- A provider determined a laboratory-confirmed alternative diagnosis.

Call school to notify of child's absence, provide symptoms and symptom onset date.

STAY HOME

Your child is considered a suspected positive COVID-19 case, and must be excluded from school and all extracurricular activities until the following conditions are met:

- At least 10 calendar days have passed since symptoms first appeared.
- No fever has been presented in the final 24 hours of the 10-day period.*
- Other symptoms have improved (for example, when cough or shortness of breath have improved).

OR

- A NEGATIVE COVID-19 test and fever-free for 24 hours*, and symptom improvement

OR

- A provider determined a laboratory-confirmed alternative diagnosis is the cause of symptoms, fever-free for 24 hours*, and symptoms have improved

Call school to notify of child's absence, provide symptoms and symptom onset date.

*Fever-free with no fever-reducing medicines used.
