Your child is considered a suspected positive COVID-19 case, and must be excluded from school and all extracurricular activities until the following conditions are met:

- At least 5 calendar days have passed since symptoms first appeared.
- No fever has been presented in the final 24 hours of the 5-day period.\*
- Other symptoms have improved (for example, when cough or shortness of breath have improved).

### OR

• A NEGATIVE COVID-19 diagnostic test and fever-free for 24 hours\*, and symptom improvement

### OR

• A provider determined a laboratoryconfirmed alternative diagnosis is the cause of symptoms, fever-free for 24 hours\*, and symptoms have improved

Call school to notify of child's absence, provide symptoms and symptom onset date.

**STAY HOME** 

Public health guidance stipulates that your child should not return to school and should not attend extracurricular activities until the following conditions are met:

- · Your child should guarantine for 5 days based on the last day of exposure to the positive COVID-19 case-patient.
- Monitor your child for symptoms and call your healthcare provider if symptoms develop. If symptoms develop within 48 hours of the last day of school attendance, notify the school.

Call school to notify of child's absence and provide information on their exposure date and expected return date.

\*Fever-free with no fever-reducing medicines used.
