

Lake Lotawana

City Summary

Lake Lotawana is an Eastern Jackson County (EJC) city with an estimated population of 2,442 people as of 2024 (+15.2 from 2019). About 11% of residents speak Spanish at home. The average household income in Lake Lotawana is the highest amongst EJC communities, and the percentage of renters that are cost-burdened is one of the lowest. Adults in Lake Lotawana also have prevalence rates of cancer and high cholesterol in the top 25% of EJC cities.

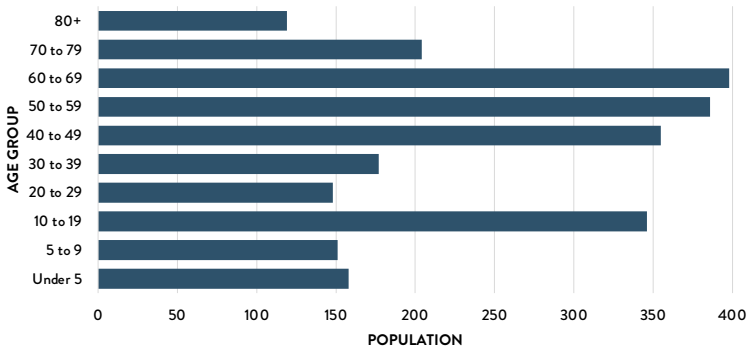

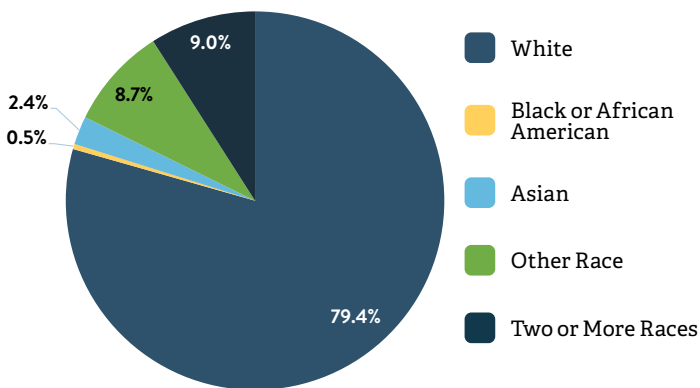

Lake Lotawana Population by Age, 2024

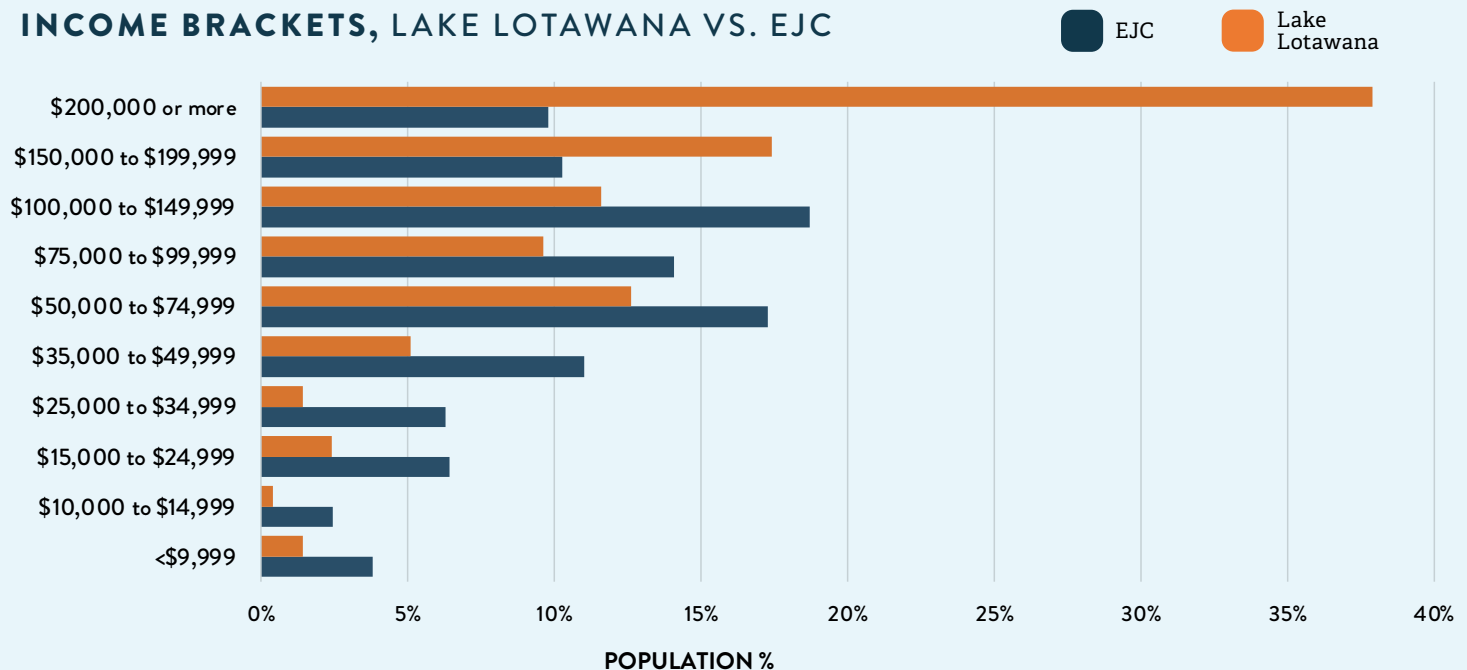


Lake Lotawana Population by Race, 2024

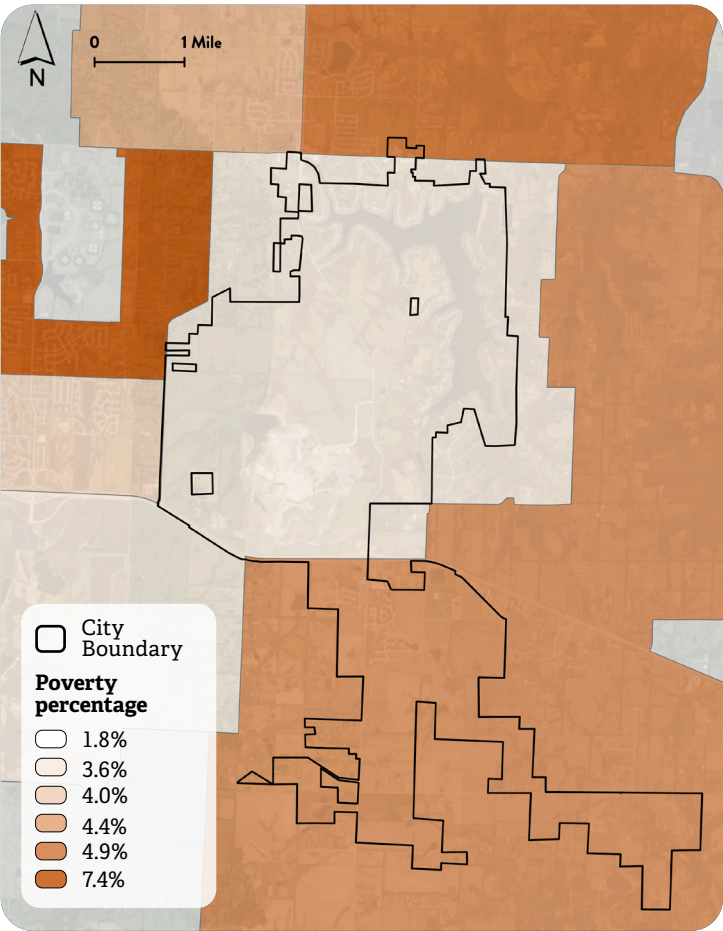
