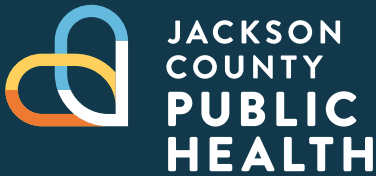


Lone Jack



City Summary

Lone Jack is an Eastern Jackson County (EJC) city with an estimated population of 1,412 people in 2024 (+3% from 2019). Residents of Lone Jack have the youngest median age in Eastern Jackson County, 32 years. The city's estimated poverty rate is in the lowest 25% amongst EJC communities, as is the percentage of residents without insurance. The estimated binge drinking prevalence is in the top 25% amongst EJC communities, but the prevalence of most chronic health conditions is in the lowest 25% of EJC communities' estimates.

- Value in the highest 25% of EJC communities
- Value in the middle 50% of EJC communities
- Value in the lowest 25% of EJC communities

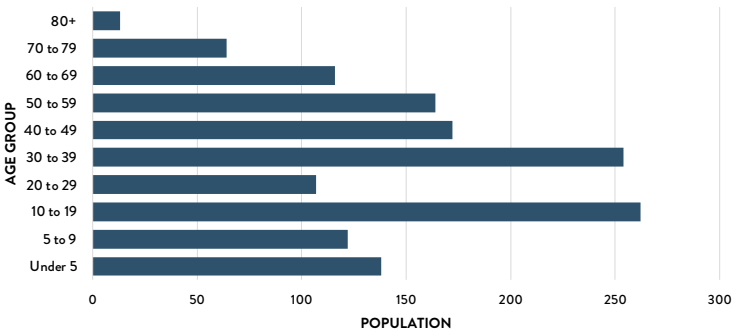

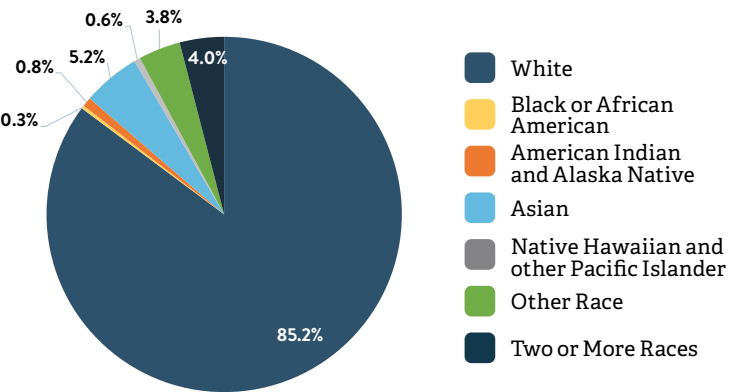

Lone Jack Population by Age, 2024

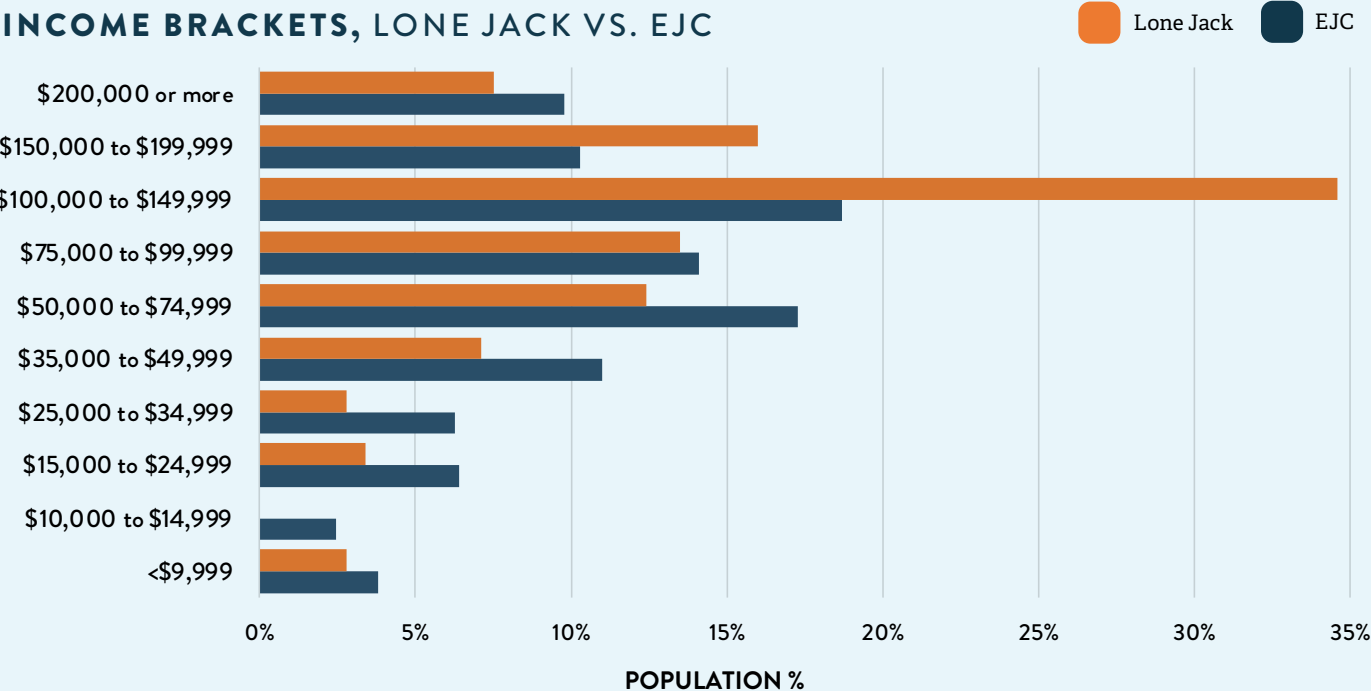


Lone Jack Population by Race, 2024

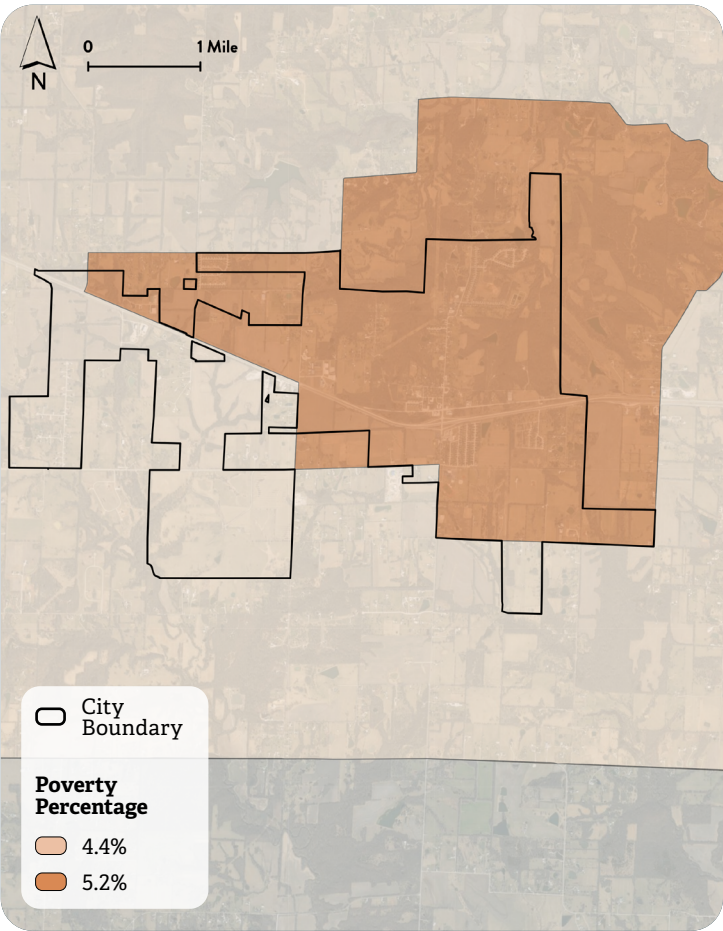
